This is a beautiful area to ride. There are many trails in this area and loops can be used to extend the ride. The ride will be about 4 -5 hours long. There are some old roads, single and double track trails -- all relatively easy with some climbs. There are spectacular views,

too! Going can be rocky, shoes are recommended.

- Bring water for your horses and yourselves, as this is an arid country.
- **WEED FREE HAY IS REQUIRED.**
- Dogs are not allowed on the trails!
- We can have a fire if fires are not banned. It would help if everyone could bring a small amount of firewood.
- Saturday night will be a potluck so bring a dish to share and something to grill. (bring a grill - if you can)

DIRECTIONS: **From Canon City** go west on US 50 to Hwy 9, go 9 miles north to CR 11, turn right and go 5.2 miles to Deer Haven Road (69).

From Denver/Colo Spgs go west on US 24 to Florissant, turn left on Teller CR 1 and go about 8 miles to Evergreen Station (right past the big Llama farm), turn right onto CR 11 and go 4 miles to the "T" intersection, turn left (Canon City), you will still be on CR 11, go another 13 miles to Deer Haven Road (69).

Once you have turned onto Deer Haven Road (Road 69) go 3.2 miles (you will go through some private property on this road, watch out for the silo!) to Wilson Creek Road #5827 and turn right, the camp area and trail head are just a 1/4 mile in from the road.
