



Twin Eagles Ride, Terryall – August 27-29th

A spectacular ride. Located reasonably close to both Colorado Springs and Denver. Be prepared for a tough climb with rewarding views overlooking the dinosaur park. This ride is planned later in the season so you will have time to condition your horse.



The first day is a challenging ride. It's a true rocky mountain trail, you'll need a decent set of shoes. The second day is flatter terrain excellent for a Fox Trot down the well marked multi-use horse/ATV trails.



The campsite is very accessible right off the pavement and includes fresh water for horses. Bring human water for yourself. This is an open ,flat, no-fee/no-amenity

What to expect: Friday arrival, dinner on your own. Social time with all. Riding in the vicinity at your leisure or with others interested in an evening ride. Saturday ready to ride at 9:00 a.m. due to possible weather conditions for reaching the summit. Plan for an all day ride. Saturday evening potluck so bring a dish to pass. Sunday riding across the road on the open forest service trails.

Directions: From the North go to the town of Jefferson. Turn south onto CO Rd 77 --Terryall Rd. Continue 20+ miles on paved road. Just past Twin Eagles camping/day use area, watch for the camp turnout which is visible from the paved road on the left side.

From the South: From Hwy 24, turn north onto CO Rd 77– Terryall Rd. Continue to campsite located on the right side visible from the paved road. Just past a commercial dude ranch on your right. If you see the Twin Eagles camp/day use area you have gone past the MSFTA campsite.
