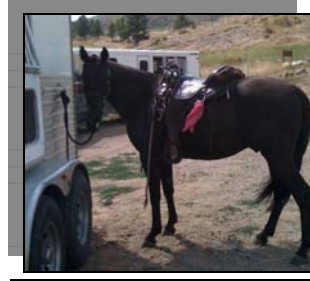


Spring Riding in the Rockies!



Sharptail Trailhead, Douglas County - May 16th



Please join us for another fun ride at Sharptail Trail. This is an excellent trail to get your horse in shape for the upcoming riding season. Terrain is hilly, with climbs and plateau's enough to let them get their breath back. Sharptail Trail runs South of Chatfield Reservoir along the Dinosaur ridge and then up into the mountains behind Sedalia eventually connecting with Indian Creek Trail.

The more adventurous of you might want to continue on into the Indian Creek trail head for a longer day. A map is included for you to print.

Directions: *From Highway 85 (Santa Fe) turn west on Titan Parkway and drive 2 miles to Roxborough Road; turn left and drive south for 3.7 miles on gravel road; Sharptail Ridge Trailhead on the left. See below for the trail system*
